Broadway Market Community Roof Garden Rules

- The roof garden will be open and available for gardening during Broadway Market business hours which are Monday through Saturday, 8 AM – 5 PM, and Sundays (May 23 to October 10, 2010) from 9 AM to 2 PM.
 - Each Plot Owner will be provided a container garden, compost and soil, and access to a water source. Seeds and seedlings may be available at a reduced cost. No chemical (blue) fertilizers, herbicides or pesticides are allowed to be used in the beds, a list of allowed natural fertilizers and information on Integrated Pest Management techniques will be made available to gardeners.
 - Vegetables, herbs, flowers and small fruit plants are allowed. No large structures, trees, or large collection of non-plant items are allowed. Crops must be legal.
 - Each group or individual must maintain their entire plot for the duration of the growing season, ending not before September 15th. A continuous succession of plants must be grown. The Broadway Market will provide workshops and information on when to start plants and extending the growing season to aid plot owners.
 - Each Plot Owner will keep a garden journal on premises to track of the days and times the plot is tended, when and what was planted, fertilizers used, problems encountered, and the resulting harvest.
 - Harvest may be sold at no cost to plot owners at the Farmers' Market on Sundays or taken for personal use.
 - Each individual allowed to garden without the Plot Owner present must be listed on the application.
 - If a Plot Owner must abandon their plot for any reason, they agree to notify garden leadership.
 - Abandoned plots will be identified when a plot appears untended, weeds are allowed to grow, nothing has been planted and/or harvested in a timely manner and the garden journal shows no recent activity. In this case, the gardener will be contacted and given one week to reclaim the plot before it is turned over to a new owner.
 - Each gardener must respect others' plots and will not tamper with, harvest, aid or assist others without their express permission. No plants should be grown so tall that they block the sun of neighboring plots. The garden will be open to the public and the Broadway Market is not responsible for vandalism or theft of vegetables or flowers. Gardeners are encouraged to harvest their crop regularly.
 - No garbage of any kind should be left at the site. Trash receptacles will be available.
 - Unattended watering is not permitted. Make sure all faucets are off when you leave the garden and hoses are neatly rolled up on the caddy.
 - Pets are not allowed in the garden or Market premises.
 - Recipes, classes on canning, making jam, nutrition, etc. will be available to plot owners.
 - Failure to follow the above rules results in the forfeiture of the plot.
- Important dates and time line:
- By May 15, there should be signs that the garden is getting started, soil should be turned and prepped for planting
 - By June 1, plants should be starting to get established in at least half of the plot
 - By June 15, there should be gardening activity throughout the entire plot

Please let garden leadership know if you are having trouble meeting these deadlines.
